

EVACUATION INFORMATION

The Western Montgomery Career & Technology Center has developed plans to respond to incidents at the Limerick Generating Station. If the school district receives notice of an <u>alert prior to 6:00 a.m.</u>, school will be closed. Plans have also been developed to address incidents, which may occur while school is in session. To make the plans effective, your cooperation is essential.

IN THE EVENT OF AN ADVISORY TO SHELTER

- Students will remain within the school building.
- Student dismissal will be delayed until the order is lifted.
- Dismissal times will be announced if they differ from scheduled dismissal times.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PICK-UP YOUR CHILDREN because it is important for everyone to remain inside during a Shelter Advisory. Students will not be dismissed during a Shelter Advisory.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EVACUATION

• Students will be transported to WMCTC "Host" school, Upper Perkiomen High School.

Students will be transported to Upper Perkiomen High School. Parents/Guardians should pick up their child at Upper Perkiomen High School no later than 8:00 P.M. once an emergency is lifted. After 8:00 P.M. our host school may be closed and any remaining students would be bused to North Penn High School.

If the Western Montgomery Career & Technology Center programs are suspended at any time during the incident, you will be notified by public radio. Tune to any of the following AM stations: WPAZ 1370, WNPV 1440, or KYW 1060. If your child's sending school or WMCTC is not in session and classes are canceled due to an emergency, DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO EITHER SCHOOL.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PICK-UP YOUR CHILDREN AT THEIR SCHOOL!

It is important that school driveways and access routes remain open for buses. In addition, while preparing to evacuate, it is difficult to release students and keep a current and accurate school census. If you must pick-up your child, please observe the appropriate access roads and building entrance designated for student pick-up. Students will only be released to parents, legal guardians, or individuals having prior approval (Approval form attached).

During the entire process, the students will remain under the supervision of the school staff.

Thank you for your cooperation. Please retain this letter for future reference. Be sure to designate who can pick-up your child on the attached "Authorization for Student Pick-up Record." Your authorization will remain in effect only during the current school term.

DIRECTIONS TO HOST SCHOOL ~ UPPER PERKIOMEN HIGH SCHOOL

(Student Pick-Up before 8:00 P.M.) 2 Walt Road, Pennsburg, PA 18073 (215) 679-5935

From Pottstown: Travel North on Rt. 663. You will pass two large bodies of water as you approach Pennsburg. Turn right at the first light in Pennsburg onto Montgomery Avenue (look for Scooty's). At the end of Montgomery Avenue, turn right onto Walt Road. Travel about 50 feet and turn left into the driveway, past the barn. Use the first parking lot and enter through the glass doors. At the end of the hallway, turn right and go up the stairs. Go in the first door on the right – it's the Library.

From Norristown: Travel North on Rt. 29, through Collegeville, Schwenksville, and Green Lane. Turn left onto 11^{th} Street in Red Hill (across from the Reed Sign Co.). Travel to the Stop sign. Go straight ahead onto Walt road. Travel about 50 feet and turn left into the driveway, past the barn. Use the first parking lot and enter through the glass doors. At the end of the hallway, turn right and go up the stairs. Go in the first door on the right – it's the Library.

From Route 309: Travel to Quakertown. Turn left onto Rt. 663 towards Pennsburg. Travel approximately 10 miles to the intersection with Rt. 29. Travel to the next traffic light and turn left onto Montgomery Avenue (look for Scooty's). At the end of Montgomery Avenue, turn right onto Walt Road. Travel about 50 feet and turn left into the driveway, past the barn. Use the first parking lot and enter through the glass doors. At the end of the hallway, turn right and go up the stairs. Go in the first door on the right – it's the Library.

From the Turnpike: Travel North on Rt. 9 to the Quakertown Exit (Exit 32). At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Rt. 663 towards Pennsburg. Travel about 5 miles to the intersection with Rt. 29. Travel to the next traffic light and turn left onto Montgomery Avenue (look for Scooty's). At the end of Montgomery Avenue, turn right onto Walt Road. Travel about 50 feet and turn left into the driveway, past the barn. Use the first parking lot and enter through the glass doors. At the end of the hallway, turn right and go up the stairs. Go in the first door on the right – it's the Library.

From the Blue Route: Take Rt. 76 (PA Turnpike) to the Northeast Extension (Rt. 476). Take Rt. 476 to Exit #31 Lansdale/Kulpsville. Upon exiting the Northeast Extension, turn left onto Sumneytown Pike. You will go approximately 2 miles to the 7th traffic light, which is valley Forge Road (Rt. 363). You will pass the stadium on your left. Turn left onto Valley Forge Rd. (Rt. 363), go ¼ mile, and North Penn's entrance is on the left. (Calvary Baptist School/Church is in our front yard

From Route 309 Expressway: Travel North on Rt. 309 from Philadelphia. Take the Norristown Road Exit. Turn left at the traffic light onto Norristown Road. (The name will change to Sumneytown Pike after the first 2 miles). For approximately 5 miles and 8 traffic lights (you will go thru the small town of North Wales, cross over railroad tracks, go under a stone bridge, pass Merck) cross over Broad Street (new CVS on the corner). Continue to Rt. 363 (Valley Forge Road). Turn right onto Valley Forge Road (Rt. 363). Go ½ mile to North Penn – entrance is on the left. (Calvary Baptist School/Church is in our front yard).

From Lower Bucks County: Take the PA Turnpike West to the Ft. Washington Exit (#26), which is Rt. 309. Take Rt. 309 North to the Norristown Rd. Exit, and then follow the directions listed above for travel by Rt. 309.

<u>AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENT PICK UP</u> <u>in the event of a school-wide emergency</u>

If you advise us who may pick up your child in the event of an evacuation emergency, the School District Officials will be able to plan more effectively to implement emergency plans. Your child will remain under the supervision of school officials during an emergency.
