Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to Western Montgomery Career & Technology Center (WMCTC). WMCTC offers parents/guardians of our students the opportunity to view your child's progress in school online. You will have access to WMCTC's Skyward system that will provide you with your child's assignments, grades, attendance, and discipline. For access to WMCTC's Skyward, utilize the link <u>https://skywardfamilyaccess.iscorp.com/western</u> or follow the directions below. If you do not have computer access available at home, you can visit our campus in person, during regular business hours or by appointment, where we can assist you through this process. It is important for you to complete the online Back-To-School paperwork for your child. Any delay in completing this paperwork may interfere with your child's ability to participate in hands-on activities in the program/shop areas.

Instructions to access Skyward and complete the paperwork for your student.

- 1. Log on to our website, <u>www.westerncenter.org</u>
- In the top right corner, under the blue "Employee Login" box, is the word POPULAR. Hover over that word, then choose the far left bubble, "Student and Family Access". This is the login page for Skyward. Enter your Login ID and Password. This is a temporary password you will be asked to change it.

NOTE: If you have "********* next to "Password:" you changed your password in a previous year and should continue using that one.

- 3. Once you're in Skyward, click on the blue link "Go To Online Registration For 'student name'" at the top of the page.
- 4. There are 7 steps to complete. On some pages, simple verification of information is required and others will need more specific information. <u>As you complete each page, be sure to mark the "complete this step" button at the bottom of the page before moving to the next page.</u> At the end of this process, there should be all green checkmarks.

Receive Emergency Notifications, School Closings, Alerts and Other School News...

SchoolMessenger®

To make sure that you're receiving school news and alerts in the ways that work best for you, Western Montgomery Career and Technology Center uses a program called SchoolMessenger. This program, which is also available as an app for smart phones and tablets, is one of the ways that we at WMCTC send out alerts, school news, school closings and emergencies. You receive email, phone calls and or/text messages directly from our school to you.

Currently, as an attendee of WMCTC, you are already enrolled in the system, but, if you would like to go in and customize how you are receiving these alerts, messages and other school updates, you can sign up for the free SchoolMessenger App. Simply go to: http://go.schoolmessenger.com to download the SchoolMessenger mobile app for Apple and

Android devices or use the web-based version from your internet browser.

Note: If you have other children attending WMCTC, they will be tied to your account by virtue of the email account you provide. Be sure to provide the same email account to WMCTC and to SchoolMessenger.

Lunch Information:

If your child participates in the lunch program at WMCTC, they will receive their lunch number on the first day of school.

If you would like to replenish your child's lunch funds, you may add money to their account in a one of two ways: **Check**: Made out to...Upper Perkiomen Food Service Dept. (UPFSD) **Online at**: www.schoolcafe.com (Registration is required. Directions below)

Registering for the <u>www.schoolcafe.com</u> account takes a few minutes. There is a convenience fee added when using this system as it will take credit card or ACH or debit payments. When registering, please list your child's school as Upper Perkiomen School District. This is because Upper Perkiomen School District manages our lunch system.
